Norma- Money from CYPSP for additional family support at level 2. Training at present on Solihul. Working to improve relationship between parent and child. Improve communication, mental health problems noted. The admin support worker taking on extra role delivering Cook it Programmes.

Julie – New Life Counselling, First meeting- busy in post primary schools, dealing with genuine and complex problems, main office in Belfast.

Andrew- Issue at present- no funding for breakfast club. Small breakfast club for Young People getting extra support who arrive early by taxi.

Alison- PCSP-working with schools on restorative justice programme, YJS, REACT, SELB and PSNI working together. Young men and anger. Working on One punch kills/without consent is rape. 16 plus- working on domestic violence issues. Web based/booklet.

Karen- Care in Crisis- 6-8 weeks waiting list, working with teenagers/primary schools, x2 counsellors in primary schools in Lurgan and 1 counsellor in GP practice. Meeting EWO soon, Lack of funding. Contacts made with Links Counselling in Lurgan.

Michaela- Working with PCSP, Young Woman's group- engaged into community. Media/Photographer project, Open event coming soon.Working in Lawerencetown at present.

Leanne- People First- Training for success, working with 16-18 year olds, NVQ's in retail/childcare, promotion of good time keeping and attendance. Working with PSNI on drug issues and online reputation. Rolling programme, new intake in September. Working with 16-21 year olds with Learning difficulties.
