



## Fermanagh Locality Planning Group Meeting

Turning the Curve Session – Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup>, March, 2015,  
Computer Suite, FRCl, Tempo Road, Enniskillen

The Fermanagh Locality Planning Group in partnership with Enniskillen Neighbourhood Renewal joined at their last meeting to explore if the area is 'Turning the Curve'. The two planned sessions were well attended and the participants had the opportunity to learn more from Helen O'Neill, Family Support Data Base about the information that can be accessed. The participants were particularly interested in the option to turn the information into one of forty three languages and as this was an interactive session, they were able to review and amend their own data captured on the site. The participants were then introduced to the CYPSP pages and viewed the sections within the Fermanagh Locality Planning Group pages and Fermanagh Family Support Hub pages.

The rest of the session was spent looking together at the Outcome Monitoring Report – Western Turning the Curve and in particular areas which are 'worsening' within Fermanagh. Participants were then able to go on themselves to the interactive maps and examine the local data under the six high level outcomes. This led to lively conversations, as the participants started to consider how they would populate the Quantitative Indicators Template which they will soon be completing which will be fed into Fermanagh's new Action Plan. The participants reported that they were surprised that so many indicators are captured particularly, around the Economic Outcome and they felt that the way that it is presented makes it easily understood.

Everyone who took part felt it was worthwhile and gave participants together the opportunity to explore both systems and many participants increased their skills on the websites.
