Ards and North Down Locality Planning Group

Launched on 25 October in the Ards Community Network with over 20 community, statutory and voluntary members committed to improving outcomes for children and families



- Merged with the pilot locality planning group in Kilcooley (endorsing priorities and action plan from this group)
- Terms of Reference for the group has been agreed & members will meet bimonthly
- Webpage for this locality group will be created on the CYPSP website > locality planning groups
- Service and statistical profiling to be commissioned through SEHSCT

Programme Priorities:

- Colin Early Parenting Programme – home-based support
- Primary school counselling service – across all six Colin primary schools
- Speech & Language Therapy – across all six Colin primary schools
- Adolescent counselling service
- EU Interreg partnership programme on ADHD treatment (**in development**)



Living in Safety and Stability

- Strengthening Families Programme
- Partnership with Parents – home-based support programme
- Incredible Years – Baby, Toddler, Preschool Dina, Basic, and School Readiness variants

Enjoying, Learning and Achieving

- Mentoring for Achievement – school-based programme (5 primaries, 7 post-primaries)
- “El Sistema” school music programme (in 2 Colin primaries) – in partnership with Shankill

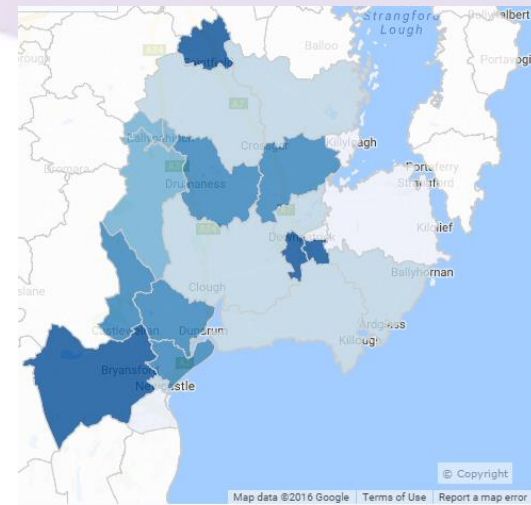
Impact measurement
