Jacqueline (HSCT) Community development worker in Armagh and Dungannon area. Work with Young People's groups/English Classes/Services in the Keady area.

YPP (Pat McGeough)

10-15 referrals per month to FSH. Telephone referrals taken. Good mix of referrals (GP's and Schools). Funding is up to September 2016

Jacqueline Connolly (SHCT) has just returned to work. SHSCT Small grants funding applications are out (older people and disability groups). £1,300 available, but there are conditions as to how this funding can be spent. Groups applying must be constituted.
