Membership

It was noted that Stephen Bergin is working in another role and his attendance may be lessened. The Education Authority are currently reviewing their membership of all groups and as Paula Keenan has completed her role with the group, she can be removed from the circulation list.

Youth Justice

A bid to fund the pilot post has been submitted, however, while there is no formal approval as yet same is expected. Catriona noted that it would be prudent to have 1-2 initiatives prepared in the event that there is a release of funding.

Catriona noted that the bid to support identified priority areas is also waiting final approval.

Children with Disability (including Intellectual Disability and Physical)

Deferred pending approval of funding request.

Survey Monkeys

Maurice noted that a survey was undertaken with a smallish response and this will be revisited.

ID Pathway including Iveagh

Catriona advised that meetings had been convened as recommended by the Rees Review to develop a standard model of service regionally for children and young people with an Intellectual Disability, which was to include access to Iveagh, however, no agreement was reached. In addition Kieran was to meet with each Trust to quantify the investment provided. A meeting was to be arranged prior to Peadar's leave and Catriona agreed to convene same to review the process to date and look at how to get a degree of consistency regionally and suggested that this forum oversee the development of same.

- ***Action – Catriona to convene meeting to include Stephen, Maurice and Kieran McShane.***

ASD Service Review

Denise noted the service have secured a bigger building, which is more appropriate to the needs of the service. Acorns for Autism, the parents' reference group, are keen to develop the garden space of the new building.

The 0-18 pathway has been developed and on advice from HR the three posts required to implement the pathway were advertised across CAMHS, but no one was appointed, therefore the pathway cannot be implemented, as there is no funding for the required posts. Catriona noted that the bid submitted when approved will support this, as an example of an integrated service model.

Discussion followed re the new "neurodevelopmental" framework, which has been shared for informal pre-consultation only with limited groups. Denise noted that she has not yet seen the paper to ascertain what is to be achieved and agree regional commonality. Maurice agreed to share same for comment.

- ***Action – Maurice to share paper with Denise for comment.***

NICCY CAMHS Review

Review is ongoing and due for publication next summer. The survey is still open and information requested has been provided re each Trust area.

RQIA Review of Emergency Services

Deferred. Catriona to seek further clarification re the recommendation that children and young people with an ID should be seen within 2 hours of presenting to ED, with follow up in 24 hours.

- ***Action – Catriona to seek further clarification re the recommendation and feedback to the group.***

Managed Care Network

The forum met in September and again yesterday. The draft Band 8B job description is being finalised for approval and the Clinical Director job description is being developed. When operational the Managed Care Network will utilise QNCC

resources. A smaller task group has been convened to develop an CAMHS / Acute Care Pathway and a draft is expected in January 2018.

It was noted there are currently a number of regional groups overseen by CSIB and CYPSP taking forward developments via task and finish groups and consideration is to be given on managing same. Maurice noted that a similar exercise was completed with the LAC Groups, which Annie will share.

- **Action – Annie to share information on the exercise completed by the LAC Group.**

Catriona noted that membership of this network is being considered and what this entails is currently being scoped.
