Locality planning emerging needs

Armagh & Dungannon: Sharp increase of Family Support Hub referrals: The main issue arising in the referrals is young people with behaviour that challenges

Banbridge: Domestic violence – increase in reporting over the World Cup period. Anti-social behaviour over the summer in Gilford. Lack of summer provision in the area.

Craigavon: Drug issue in Portadown among young people in the areas of Pleasure Gardens and the Meadows. The use of herbal cannabis a growing trend in the area. Gambling increasing in the area. Interagency group set up. Issue to be monitored

Dungannon: Behaviour that challenges, depression, anxiety about summer months routine holiday hunger, affording school uniforms, anxiety, Universal Credit – families waiting for money, glitches, closed cases, young people unable to find affordable temporary accommodation and stress of getting to college. Parents support services running at full capacity. Women's Aid taking longer to process support work and to commence: weeks to get into routine of meeting due to complex high need, high volume of referrals, many complex issues and Social Services criteria is high

Newry: Reliance on volunteers to undertake a high amount of work in the community

South Armagh: lack of provision for primary school-age children, lack of facilities and summer scheme activities, reduced youth provision due to lack of volunteers and difficulty recruiting youth leaders, lack of mental health services for all ages: need to focus on wellness and recovery.

All LPG's are currently producing their action plans for 2018-20
