Two Trauma Sensitive Practice session the Safeguarding Board for Northern Ireland in
partnership with the HSC Leadership Centre has developed a Train for Trainers Programme for
all organisations.

Objectives of the Train for Trainers Programme

By the end of this two day training programme the participant will;

- Have developed training skills and continuous professional development by becoming a Trauma Informed Practice Trainer
- Be able to support their organisations consistency of common language and understanding of ACEs and trauma sensitive approaches to practice across the system in Northern Ireland
- Be informed and confident to deliver a minimum of three Level One and Level Two awareness programmes per year post attending the Train the Trainer programme using the training resources and guidance documents.

Audience

A set of criteria has been outlined below to enable potential participants to understand their suitability for the programme

- Occupational a minimum of three years' experience of direct service delivery with children or adults
- Vocational (desirable but not essential) a minimum of one year's experience in the delivery of training
- Ensure there has been a commitment from senior management to provide ongoing support and continuous professional development for you in this trainers role through the future delivery of this training programme
