# **Belfast Resilience Strategy**

#### Overview

Thank you for your interest in Belfast's draft Resilience Strategy. This work aims to 'future proof' Belfast- so that the city is ready for the challenges we face this century.

Belfast is a member of a global network of cities like Barcelona, Cape Town, San Francisco and Christchurch, all working to reduce vulnerabilities and build our capacity to adapt to shocks and stresses. Each city has appointed a Commissioner for Resilience- a role to help collaboration across cities, and enable them to identify the major risks they face, and to agree ways to respond. This draft strategy is the first time that we have mapped out the major strategic risks-shocks and stresses- to the city of Belfast and put together a draft plan in response. Your input is hugely important as we work towards our goal to make Belfast more resilient- to transition to an inclusive, low-carbon, climate-resilient economy in a generation.
